

Suggested venues for Cultural Events at CR

Performing Arts Theater (SS/T building)

- Seats 300+ in comfortable seating
- Stage, professional lighting and sound, movie screen, lectern, can live stream to the theater

Dr. Eugene Portugal Student Services / Administration Building

- Downstairs or upstairs lobbies
- Board Room

Gym

- Can seat a up to 500+ people in bleachers and on the ground
- Floor covering is required for general events, so gym must be closed the day prior and the day after an event at a minimum.
- Concession stand available in lobby
- Can be set up for lectern and sound, but quality is not as clear as in the theater

Field House

- Large open room
- 19,000 square feet with sport court

HU lecture rooms

- Seat approx. 90+ people in comfortable seating
- Can stream video to screen, internet access from lectern

Stadium

- Newly refinished track surface
- Bleachers seat 200+ and can be moved as needed
- Field is available, although athletics games take priority and field must remain in good condition for athletic events.
- Concession stand available
