

Student Feedback Regarding Technology in Instruction

A technology survey was administered to students in 2014-2015 and 2015-2016. In addition to gathering student's satisfaction with various technology-related services, the survey also asked the following question:

 Is there any one thing that your instructors can do with technology to better support your academic success?

A total of 68 students provided written comments to this question.

- 32.4% of students indicated that there is nothing that the instructors need to do differently.
- 7.4% of students indicated that the instructors should be using better equipment.
- 27.9% of students made reference to instructors use of Canvas

Student comments about Canvas:

- If all teachers used canvas, but I understand that not everyone is tech-savvy so its not always possible.
- Faculty instruction on Canvas needs to be MANDATORY. There are still many instructors who either do not utilize Canvas to its potential or just don't know what they are doing with it. The tool is right there- make them learn how to use it.
- All instructors should be required to use Canvas, it greatly improves success. Some instructors have no idea how to use canvas, some barely even know how to use a computer. They need to be taught
- Post all lecture material (.ppt, media links, etc.) on canvas prior to class.
- Open the class site to Canvas and post their power points for easy review of the lectures.
- Continue using web advisor a d canvas as well as optimath

- Online classes should come out of the Dark ages and incorporate Canvas with online line classes.
