2. ACTION

- 2.1.Decide Which Integrative Planning Functional Committee Is Responsible for Ranking Which Resource Requests.
 - Sub-group completed parsing the resource request list. Discussed and agreed that instructional materials requests would be ranked by the BPC.
 - Conflicts in Life/Safety rankings will be determined by the chairs of each functional committee.
 - BPC tab rankings (which are the whole committee) are due to BPC chairs no later than January 11. The committee will meet on January 18 to complete the BPC rankings as a group.

3. DISCUSSION
