Degree for Transfer	Mathematics	Nonsub Revision	Credit	Effective Fall 2024: Modified program description, updated PLO's, added program narrative, removed frequently cancelled programming course, and added new options for articulated programming courses in accordance with Assist.org and the Transfer Model Curriculum.
A.A. Degree for Transfer	Communications Studies 2.0	Nonsub Revision	Credit	Effective Fall 2025: While this proposal is going through the curriculum approval process as a "new program," it is essentially a revision of our existing ADT. The transfer model curriculum for communication studies was updated to version 2.0. This proposal reflects the new TMC and updates the learning objectives from the previous program. Comm Studies 2.0 will replace the existing Comm ADT. The existing ADT will be deactivated when Comm 2.0 becomes active.
