Student Payment Plans & Nelnet

A few years ago, CR contracted with the loan servicing company **Nelnet** to allow students to set up an online fee payment plan. We recently collected data showing that the payment plan is underutilized. We have taken steps to address this by reducing the down payment required of students to 10 percent and extending the length of the repayment period. We hope that this will make the payment amounts more reasonable for students. Please help us get the word out that Nelnet is a good option for students who want to avoid de-registration. The Business Office has Nelnet fliers outlining the available payment plans.

CR Leadership to Participate in the Cascadia Leadership Program

CR has been awarded \$50,000 to send VPs, Deans, and Directors (25 in total) to the **ten day Cascadia Leadership Program** offered through the Humboldt Area Foundation. The training will take place in summer 2017. Outcomes of the training include:

- Increased ability to lead and participate in high performance teams
- Expertise to design and lead meetings that build collaboration, commitment and generate positive action
- Greater awareness of the role of fear in leading and have strategies to turn it into creativity and enthusiasm
