## Overview of changes during the past 12 months:

- Articulation Agreements being put in place with local high schools and the CT 21A course.
- Program Review updates.
- Purchase of building lots, and the return to the previously used 3 lot model.
- Equipment upgrades to the AT 109 woodworking facility.
- Current work on the '08-09 set of residential cabinets.

Discussion and response from members of the Woodworking and Cabinetmaking Advisory Committee were as follows:

- Importance on emphasizing flow of work, gender requirements, and job etiquette during cabinet installation.
- The appropriate use of nitrocellulose and catalyzed lacquers.
- The economic value of punctuality.
- Use of pocket screws for face frame installation.
- Satisfaction with the return of the 3 lot model, and willingness to support its continuance.
